HURLEY FIELD AUDIENCE

Hurley Field is the Berkley School District's soccer, football, and track & field stadium. Located behind Anderson Middle School at 3205 Catalpa between Coolidge and Greenfield roads, Hurley Field is one of the premier high school complexes in the Detroit metropolitan area. Completely renovated in August, 2002 (plus new turf in 2012, and track in 2010) and open from mid-March to the end of November each year, Hurley Field schedules over 300 event days totaling over an average of 800 hours of activities each year, with average attendance estimated to be over 53,000 people annually.

Hurley Field serves as the home field for Berkley School District soccer, football and track & field teams. In addition, a number of local community-area youth sports teams play all or some of their home games at Hurley Field including Berkley Youth Soccer Association (BYSA), Berkley Steelers Youth Football and Huntington Woods Bulldogs Youth Football.

Hurley Field has also been used by a number of outside groups for both practice sessions and games during the past eleven years. Among these groups has been the Michigan Bucks men's soccer team of the Premier Development League (PDL), Brother Rice High School, Vardar youth soccer, Marian High School girl's soccer team and numerous teams of the Michigan United Soccer League (MUSL) to name a few. It has also hosted numerous Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) soccer and football tournament games during its 17 years of operation.
