TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES AND PROVEN EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGIES

- Classroom technology and sound amplification systems as needed
- Replace obsolete telephone and PA systems
- Building-wide secured Wi-Fi
- High-speed data network upgrades



SAFETY UPGRADES

- Upgrade building access and camera systems
- Centrally monitored fire alarm systems



CLASSROOM UPGRADES AND BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS

- Improve air quality, fresh air and temperature controls for student comfort and energy efficiency
- Replace classroom, office and corridor finishes as required by other work
- Update select educational furniture and equipment
- Improve opportunity for student and adult collaboration and exploration
- Improve accessibility per American Disabilities Act



CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

- Provide air conditioning to support year-round use of building
- Heating, ventilation, ductwork, controls and piping
- Replace obsolete electrical system components
- Replace lighting to improve learning environment and energy efficiency
- Remodel select restrooms and replace obsolete and worn plumbing fixtures and piping
- Replace select doors, windows, roofing, railings and exterior steps
- Correct site drainage where needed
