 - 1. New program at Burton and other schools in the district DEI, means diversity, equity and inclusion.

- V. Good of the Order
 - A. Comment: Expressed concerns about FunRun inclusivity related to timing for parents to attend and for children with other needs
 - 1. This year our ASD team will help make a sensory run for students who can't or don't want to participate
 - B. Q: Have we ever done a Food Truck?
 - 1. They don't donate back to us historically and they have minimums. It is a different investment for them than a restaurant night
 - 2. Rays wants to do an ice cream night with us
 - C. Q: What academic elements does the PTA pay for? How does the funding get used and is it all academic?
 - 1. Funds are used primarily on academic tools e.g., classroom supply funds, Handwriting without Tears program, Buses, OT tools, etc.
 - D. Q: Could we see a more running visual of the budget and the itemized spending, like where we are on budget by month and it's available monthly with the agenda?
 - 1. Yes, the budget is available to view and we will work to have a snapshot for upcoming meetings to share
