

BERKLEY SKI AND SNOWBOARD CLUB 2022

1. Ski and Snowboard Club is open to Berkley High School and Middle School students and their parents. Younger students can participate with their parents. All applications and fees must be dropped off at AMS.
2. We will plan to ski on the following dates:
 - a. January 7, 14 (11:30), 21, 28
 - b. February 4, 11 (11:30), 18 (11:30)
3. The bus from BHS leaves promptly at 3:45, middle school busses leave at 3:30. All busses leave Mt. Holly at 9:00 sharp. Please pick your student up from their school no later than 10:00.
4. Dates may change due to weather conditions. If Berkley Schools is cancelled, ski club will be cancelled as well. Additionally, if Holly Schools are closed ski club may be cancelled as well.
5. Unfortunately, no membership fees or bus fees will be refunded.
6. If a parent is picking up their own student from Mt. Holly please make arrangement with the sponsor prior to pick up. Students may only ride home with their own parent unless arranged thru the sponsor.
7. We ski on a student lift ticket (discount price), therefore, we must comply with the Ski School Patch Program.
8. 2022 Fees – Bussing fees due prior to first trip until all seats are filled.

ONE TIME FEES

- a. Bus and membership fees \$185
- b. Must be turned into any school main office, all checks payable to Anderson Middle School.

WEEKLY FEES

- c. Weekly lift ticket \$25
- d. Rental equipment \$25
- e. Weekly fees must be paid on the bus, checks payable to Mt. Holly
- f. Students that provide their own transportation can purchase membership cards, lift tickets and rentals at the Berkley Schools table in the Mt. Holly cafeteria from 4:00-6:30 on ski nights or 11:00-1:30 on half days. Checks payable to Mt. Holly

9. Members must fill out registration form and rental agreement (serves as a waiver for Mt. Holly)
10. Students must be responsible for their own gear, use the free ski and snowboard check.
