

Spotlight on: MYP IB Learning

Advanced artists created tissue paper under microscope drawings. They first discussed bone and connective tissue, structure and development, while examining photographs. They started by drawing organic shapes making sure to leave stream like sections in between. They had to do 5 layers of this and add value in each "stream." Black marker was added for contrast as well as color pencil shadows to create the illusion of depth.
