Great Parks for Great People

- Must be 16 by July 1, 2022
- Train 20-30 hours on evenings & weekends in May-June 18
- Work 20-40 hours/week starting June 18-Sept. 5

Parks Attendant \$12.63/hr

Train 10-20 hours evenings before June 17, work a flexible schedule through Labor Day

Lifeguards \$15.35/hr

- 1. Complete two (2) 10-hour training days in May, training is conducted on Saturdays & Sundays
- 2. Pass the online examination to become certified as a Jeff Ellis & Associates lifeguard. Exam fee paid by OCPR
- 3. Work 100 hours of paid lifeguard service at the Waterparks and receive a \$300 bonus
