CROSS THE LINE LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Leadership: A 16-week program designed to empower LGBTQ+ youth ages 12-20. Leadership skills utilized from curricula focus on understanding power and privilege, LGBTQ+ 101, facilitation and presentation skills, creative advocacy approaches, mentorship, community engagement, and social risks prevention such as bullying, HIV/STI, domestic violence and sexual assault.

Workforce: A 16-week program designed to empower LGBTQ+ youth ages 12-24 with soft and hard skills necessary for successful workforce navigation. Utilizes theoretical and practical application, the program provides 4 weeks of interac- tive training and 10 weeks of on-the-job training.

Youth Drop-In: Every Friday and Saturday, 4 to 9 p.m., for youth ages 12-20. Open to empower youth, only trained adult such as designated interns, Adult Allies and Staff are permitted. The Drop-In provides a safe place for youth to en- gage their peers for networking, fun, and learning. Equipped with an XBOX 360, games, pool table, board games, WIFI, Netlflix, and much more. 


