You will be testing at:

CASA: Center for the Advanced Studies and the Arts 23561 Rosewood Oak Park, MI 48237 | CASA Main Office: 248-586-8860 *Transportation is <u>NOT</u> provided. You need to find your own ride.*

(note: AP Exams usually last 3-3.5 hours)

You do <u>NOT</u> need to call the BHS Attendance Line for your AP exam.

- CASA will provide BHS the list of students present for each AP Exam.
- BHS will use the list to excuse those students for the <u>entire</u> school day.
- If you would like to attend some of your BHS classes that day of your AP Exam, please let your teachers know, so they can mark you present.

7:30 AM	You will NOT be admitted to the test after 7:50 AM .
for 8:00 AM exam	This is the College Board rule. No exceptions.
<mark>11:30 AM</mark>	You will NOT be admitted to the test after 11:50 AM .
for 12:00 PM exam	This is the College Board rule. No exceptions.

You <u>MUST</u> have your PHOTO ID to be admitted to the test!

What if I missed the Pre-Bubbling session on 4/28?

- Please arrive at CASA at least 20 minutes early on the day of your AP Exam.
- Once you are checked in and report to your testing room, let the proctor know you need to pre-bubble your answer sheet.

What are the dates for AP Exams?

• Here is the AP Exam schedule.

I am registered for an AP exam but cannot test on the AP Exam date, can I test at a later date?

- Yes. Here is the <u>schedule for AP late-test dates</u>.
- If you wish to switch your registration to the late-test date, please click here ASAP.
 - You will need to pay a <u>\$100 late fee</u> via MiStar or bring a check (*payable to Berkley HS*) to the Student Services Center and hand it to Mrs. Folk.

What if I no longer want to take the AP Exam?

- If you no longer want to take the AP Exam, simply do not show up to take the AP Exam.
- You will <u>not</u> receive any refund. You will be expected to attend your BHS classes on the date you were planning to take the AP Exam.

What if I am sick on the day of the AP Exam?

- If you are sick on the day of an exam, you would need to have a note from a doctor or email from a parent/guardian explaining that you were sick (proof for AP).
- A <u>late exam can be ordered</u>, but it would need to be within a 24-hour window of the exam; you cannot wait for a week to decide to take the late exam. <u>Click here</u> to register for a late AP Exam.
- You would have to pay the \$100 late fee.
 - The exact wording from AP to be <u>exempt from late fees</u> is *"a student must have a medical emergency"*. Feeling ill is not their definition of medical emergency. Hospitalizations are medical emergencies. And CASA would have to have documentation proving this.
