Oakland Schools Cosmetology Program

Cosmetology is a 1500-hour program. For a student to complete the state hours required and to be eligible to test for the State Board Exam by the end of his or her senior year, below is the pathway option that we recommend:

- Three weeks of summer school (16 days 7 hours per day) between Sophomore and Junior year
- Traditional AM or PM session during Junior Year (2.5 hours per day)
- Three weeks of summer school (16 days 7 hours per day) between Junior and Senior year
- Traditional PM session + Extended Day 11:20 am to 4:20 pm during Senior Year (5 hours per day)
 Note: The Extended Day Session is for 2nd Year Cosmetology students ONLY and <u>students must make</u> <u>arrangements for their own transportation</u>.
