4. Administrators Reports

(Paul Yowchuang)

- * Thanked the PTSA and Norup Community for a successful Dance Fit Challenge.
- * Thanked the PTSA and Norup Community for a successful Drive Through Trunk or Treat.
- * The plan for PYP to return to in person class instruction has been put on hold due to the rise in Covid-19 cases.
- * There have also been meetings about a return to in person learning for Middle and High School students as well. There is no definitive date to return, it depends on the Covid-19 rates and safety protocols established by Oakland County.
- * The Staff is still looking at ways for students to engage with each other in person. Some staff members such as Mrs. Goldberg and Mrs. Talucchi are eager to run some clubs with a small group of students, while other staff members are apprehensive.

11. Caring and Sharing- Mikey Keating

Due to Covid, this event will look **very different** this year. There will be no food collection & distribution of any kind. Instead, Caring & Sharing will consist of a virtual fundraiser (GoFundMe) and funds donated from PTAs/PTSAs/schools. Those funds will be used to purchase grocery gift cards for families in need.

As a district, we have historically fed between 100-130 families in the Berkley School district and provided food boxes for area veterans. We spend about \$5,000.00 each year to purchase turkeys, extra food, fresh produce, bread and other items we don't collect through our non-perishable food drive. Funds for the program come from our schools and the Hat Day events.
