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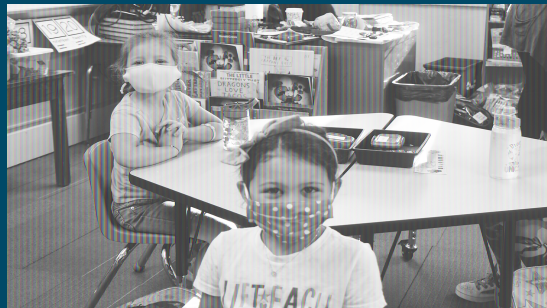

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TK Curriculum

- **TRANSITION YEAR:** bridges Preschool & Kindergarten skills
- **LIFE SKILLS:** works and plays well with others, practices self-control, follows directions, develops independence, shows responsibility, resolves problems effectively
- ★ **READING:** names upper/lower case letters, identifies beginning sounds, rhyming, phonemic awareness, retells stories, narrative/informational text ★

Promotes positive socialization, hands-on learning, and emergent literacy. There is also an ample amount of play time

- **WRITING:** forms letters correctly, brainstorms ideas, writes personal narratives using pictures and labels
- **MATH:** builds number sense, identifies and creates patterns, shapes, counts to 30

- **READING:** names upper/lower case letters, identifies beginning sounds, rhyming, phonemic awareness, sight words, retells stories, narrative/informational text





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Kindergarten Curriculum



- **WRITING:** forms letters correctly, brainstorms ideas, correctly spells frequently encountered words, writes personal narrative, how-to and persuasive writing pieces using words and pictures
- **MATH:** builds number sense, identifies and creates patterns, shapes, reads and writes to 30, solves simple +/- problems, counts to 100

- Science: Building a Sense of Wonder in the World Around Us, Force and Motion, Weather, Plants and Animals.
- Social Studies: Navigating Our School, Working as a Team, and My Place in Time

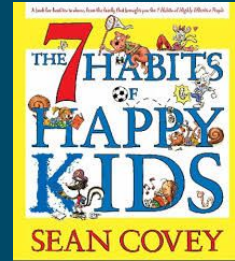

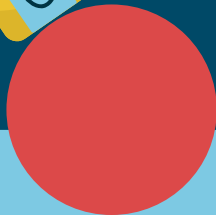

May 16- May 20, 2022 - Registration Period

June 1 (after) - Families are notified, first month's tuition will be due in September

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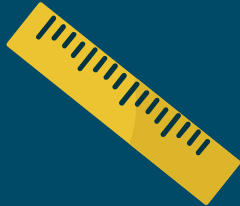
