Dear Parents of a Fifth Grade Student,

We are happy to inform you that YMCA Storer Camps representatives will be visiting Rogers on December 16, 2019. The representatives will meet with our students that day to explain what camp is like and what to expect as they get ready to go on February 24, 2019. Later that day, we teachers will meet with our district team to plan lessons for the camp experience. Attending Camp Storer is a wonderful, educational opportunity!

That evening, there will be a **parent meeting** so that you may also hear about camp and ask questions of Camp Storer staff and district administrators. All district elementary schools will have a combined parent meeting. Please mark your calendars to save the date and time: **Monday, December 16, 2019, at 6:00 p.m., in the Berkley High School Auditorium.** To be well-informed about camp, it is important for you to attend this meeting.

As indicated in our previous letter, the **cost of camp is \$200.00** (reduced from \$300, thanks to a generous donation from the Rogers PTA). A payment plan was provided, with the **final payment due by Friday, February 7th**. In addition to paying for camp, **health forms must be completed online for your child by Monday, February 3rd**. On our website, you will also find additional important information about camp, including the "Bring Along" List which indicates what to pack, information regarding the camp's health services, an important letter from Camp Storer to parents, and a Trading Post order form which is also attached to this letter. **If your child wishes to order Trading Post items, please complete the order form and return it with a check made payable to Rogers Elementary School by Friday, February 7th.**

It is our hope and expectation that all students attend camp as it is not only a great experience but part of our fifth grade curriculum. Every student should participate in this wonderful learning opportunity! If you have financial or other circumstances that may interfere with your child's participation, please inform your child's teacher or contact Mrs. Meacham.
