Studies have documented that regardless of the economic, ethnic, or cultural background of the family, family involvement in a child's education is a major factor in determining success in school.

"No matter what the demographics, students are more likely to earn higher grades and test scores, attend school regularly, have better social skills, graduate and go on to post-secondary education when schools and families partner," said Karen Mapp, Ed.D., a leading education researcher on school, family and community partnerships and lecturer at the Harvard Graduate School on Education.

Family involvement is a commitment made by the parent with the help of the school and community. It is too basic and necessary of an effort to be an option.
