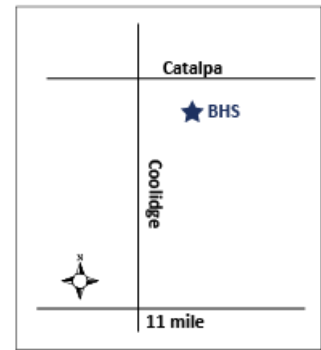

The Berkley School District is pleased to offer the following courses for middle school credit and credit recovery:

Coursework will be delivered through direct teacher instruction for Language Arts and Math courses and online via the APEX online learning system for Science and Social Studies, assisted, facilitated and overseen by certified teachers. These courses are tailored to each student and are mastery-based which means the length of time students must spend in Summer School will vary and is dependent upon mastery of course objectives. All coursework adheres to and is aligned with the standards and benchmarks of the Michigan Department of Education and the Berkley School District. Students may take up to two semester classes during Summer School and the final day to begin a new class during the Summer School window is at the discretion of the program coordinator.

Schedule

Students should select a time slot during which they take the class(es):

8:00 AM – 10:15 AM and/or 10:20 AM - 12:30 PM.

Classes are held Monday - Thursday. Classes will not meet on Wednesday, July 4. Spaces are limited for each time slot, so be sure to sign-up soon.

Breakfast is available for purchase every morning before school or during the mid-morning break. Students eligible for free/reduced-fare lunch may receive breakfast for free or at a reduced rate

Behavior/Attendance Policy

Students are responsible for completing coursework during the time-span provided. Academic credit will not be granted if the student does not complete coursework, so attendance is of utmost importance. Students who have more than two absences will be at risk of not receiving academic credit.

Disruptive behavior on school grounds will not be tolerated, and may result in removal from the summer school program. Refunds will not be provided under these circumstances.

Fees

The fee is \$160 per class. Any BSD student who is eligible for free/reduced-fare lunch will receive their first class at a reduced rate of \$50/class. Additional classes are at the regular tuition rate.

Payment is due at the time of registration.

Students who choose to drop classes will be charged a \$30 fee. No refunds will be granted after the second class period.
